Introduction

Introduction to InferStack Webinar

Our webinar gives a 45 minute Introduction to InferStack, its capabilities and applications with a live demonstration of the major features of this Internet of Things environment.

This will allow participants to get a deep dive understanding of the Power and Capability of InferStack as a Building Internet of Things Platform. Participants are able to ask questions at the end of the presentation and live demo.

Online Study

After the Introductory webinar, we recommend you review the videos and documents available on the portal to get an understanding of the capabilities, features and use of the product. Requirements:
